APRIL DAYS OF SIGNIFICANCE

We are proud to share these upcoming special days and holidays with our residents. Acknowledging and celebrating these days pf significance supports a sense of community through inclusion.



April 2 – Palm Sunday: Passion Sunday, in the Christian tradition, the first day of Holy Week and the Sunday before Easter, commemorating Jesus Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. It is associated in many churches with the blessing and procession of palms (leaves of the date palm or twigs from locally available trees).



April 5 – Passover begins: In Israel, Passover is the seven-day holiday of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, with the first and last days celebrated as legal holidays and as holy days involving holiday meals, special prayer services, and abstention from work; the intervening days are known as Chol HaMoed ("Weekdays [of] the Festival").




April 7 & 9 – Good Friday & Easter: - Good Friday is a Christian holiday commemorating the crucifixion of Jesus and his death at Calvary. It is observed during Holy Week as part of the Paschal Triduum.



April 17 – Laylat al-Qadr, "Night of Power": Islamic festival that commemorates the night on which God first revealed the Qur'ān to the Prophet Muhammad through the angel Gabriel (Jibrīl). It is believed to have taken place on one of the final 10 nights of Ramadan in 610 CE, though the exact night is unclear. The date of the annual commemoration thus varies throughout the Islamic world but is most commonly observed on the 23rd night of Ramadan for Shi'i Muslims and on the 27th for Sunni Muslims.



April 18 - Yom Hashoah: In Israel, it is a national Memorial Day. The first official commemorations took place in 1951, and the observance of the day was anchored in a law passed in 1959.



April 21 – Eid-al-Fitr/End of Ramadan: Eid, which is Arabic for 'feast' or 'festival', is celebrated by Muslims to mark significant events in the Islamic lunar calendar. In the 9th month, commonly known as Ramadan, Muslims far and wide observe fasting from dawn to dusk.

Eid al-Fitr is the festival of the breaking of fast where family and friends come together to indulge in a spread.
