Union Villa is committed to providing quality care to our residents and we seek constructive feedback on the services we provide. Union Villa takes all concerns and complaints seriously and ensures compliance with the standards set out in the Fixing Long-term Care Act 2021.

Residents and family members are encouraged to discuss any issues with their home area staff, and, if the issue is not resolved, to speak with the Nurse Manager, Director of Care or the Administrator for further investigation.

Any person raising a concern/complaint will be informed of the outcome of the investigation and possible strategies for resolution.

Union Villa will not condone any retaliation measures towards a person who brings forward a concern/complaint. Residents or family members will not be a subject to discriminatory treatment if they report a complaint.

Further information on our concern/complaint and whistle blowing policies is posted on each unit and on the first floor information board (located by the elevator) along with information for reporting an unresolved complaint directly to the Ministry of Long-term Care and/or the Patient Ombudsman.
