Position Summary:

Reporting to the Manager of Environmental Services, the Maintenance Technician will be responsible for ensuring that equipment and systems utilized within Unionville Home Society are in excellent working condition, and that tenants/residents requests for service are completed in a timely and professional manner.

Duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Maintenance and repair of equipment as required: windows, furnace filters, kitchen drains, heating systems;
- Maintaining the proper safety and working conditions of electrical breakers, emergency lighting, extinguishers, smoke detectors and other equipment;
- Provide support to general maintenance staff as required in minor repairs, snow removal and lawn maintenance;
- Monthly checks of fire safety equipment: extinguishers, hoses, evacuation chairs
- Ensure that all scheduled work and assigned tasks are completed on a timely basis

- Successful completion of BES 1 and BES 2 certification;
- Ability to exercise good judgement, tact and diplomacy;
